ORDINANCE 20-11

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER II, ADMINISTRATION,
SECTION 2-7.8 BOARD OF RECREATION COMMISSIONERS, OF THE REVISED GENERAL
ORDINANCES OF THE BOROUGH OF KEYPORT

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF KEYPORT AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I. Amendments:

2-7.8 Board of Recreation Commissioners.

- a. Board Established; Appointment of Members. (Unchanged)
- b. Membership; Terms of Office; Vacancies; Uncompensated Service. The Board of Recreation Commissioners shall consist of seven (7) members and two (2) alternate members, designated Alternate One and Alternate Two and Alternate Three who are citizens and residents of the Borough of Keyport. The Commissioners, except for the alternates, first appointed shall hold office for one (1), two (2), three (3), four (4) and five (5) years respectively, in such a manner that the term of at least one (1) Commissioner and not more than (2) Commissioners shall expire in each year. Thereafter, all appointments shall be for the term of five (5) years, and vacancies shall be filled for the unexpired term only. Alternate One first appointed shall hold office for four years one (1) year, Alternate Two first appointed shall hold office for three (3) years. Thereafter the alternates shall hold office be for the term of five (5) years, and vacancies shall be filled for the unexpired term only. The members shall serve until their respective successors are appointed and shall qualify. the members shall receive no compensation for their services.

SECTION II. Severability:

Each section, subsection, sentence, clause and phrase of this Ordinance is declared to be an independent section, subsection, sentence, clause and phrase, and the finding or holding of any such portion of this Ordinance to be unconstitutional, void, or ineffective for any cause, or reason, shall not affect any other portion of this Ordinance.

SECTION III. Effective date:

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its adoption and any publication as may be required by law.
