

ORDINANCE #9-12

AN ORDINANCE TO EXTEND THE PARKING PROHIBITION ALONG THE SOUTH SIDE OF SNYDER LANE

WHEREAS, as provided in Section 7-3.3, Parking Prohibited at All Times on Certain Streets, of the Revised General Ordinances of the Borough of Keyport, no person shall park a vehicle at any time upon any of the streets or parts thereof described in Schedule I attached to and made a part of Chapter VII, Traffic, of the Revised General Ordinances of the Borough of Keyport; and

WHEREAS, as set forth on Schedule I, parking is presently prohibited (1) along the entire portion of the North side of Snyder Lane, and (2) on the South side of Snyder Lane for a distance of 25 feet from the corner of Snyder Lane and Spring Street; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council have determined that it is in the best interest of the Borough of Keyport to modify Schedule I to extend the prohibition on parking along the South side of Snyder Lane to a distance of 96 feet from the corner of Snyder Lane and Spring Street.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Keyport as follows:

SECTION I. Amendments to Schedule I of Chapter VII of the Revised General Ordinances of the Borough of Keyport.

With respect to the South side of Snyder Lane in the Borough of Keyport, Schedule I of the Revised General Ordinances of the Borough of Keyport is hereby amended and revised to read as follows:

SECTION II. Inconsistent Ordinances.

All Ordinances or parts thereof inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION III. Severability.

Each section, subsection, sentence, clause and phrase of this Ordinance is declared to be an independent section, subsection, sentence, clause and phrase, and the finding or holding of any such portion of this Ordinance to be unconstitutional, void,



or ineffective for any cause, or reason, shall not affect any other portion of this Ordinance.

SECTION IV. Effective date.

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its adoption and any publication as may be required by law.
