#### Please provide a drawing or other accurate representation of the property. This must include information on both the Henhouse and surrounding Enclosure/Pen:

A) Location of the henhouse and the enclosure/pen in relation to any existing structure on the property AND any structures on any adjacent properties if the henhouse is less than 25 feet from any property line

B) Distance from the henhouse to the nearest property line AND all property lines if the henhouse is less than 25 feet from any property line

C) Distance from the henhouse to the street, if there is no primary residence on the property OR if no rear yard exists.

B) The location and dimensions of the enclosure/pen or fenced area where the chickens will be kept during the daylight hours.

C) The enclosure/pen must "provide adequate sun and shade and must be impermeable to rodents, wild birds and predators, including dogs and cats".

#### How will you attempt to accomplish this?

#### Please provide information on the proposed henhouse. Keyport ordinance requires:

"Chickens shall be secured within a henhouse during non-daylight hours. The structure shall be enclosed on all sides and shall have a roof and doors. Access doors must be able to be shut and locked at night. Opening windows and vents must be covered with predator and bird-proof wire of less than one (1) inch openings. The use of scrap, waste board, sheet metal or similar materials is prohibited.

#### How will you attempt to accomplish this?

# Please provide information on your proposed feed and water station(s)/location Such feed and water must be unavailable to rodents, wild birds and predators. Keyport Ordinance requires:

Odors from chickens, chicken manure or other chicken related substances shall not be perceptible at the property boundary/property line.

Perceptible noise at the property line must be "reasonable".

Only motion activated lighting may be used to light the exterior of the henhouse.

All necessary actions to reduce the attraction of predators and rodents and the potential infestation of insects and parasites must be taken by the owner.

Chickens that are diseased must be promptly removed.

Any carcasses must be disposed of promptly and in a sanitary manner.

Chickens must be provided with feed and water at all times and such feed and water must be unavailable to rodents, wild birds and predators.

Uneaten feed must be removed in a timely manner.

The henhouse, enclosure/pen and surrounding areas must be kept free from trash and manure.

Accumulated manure must be regularly removed.

All stored manure must be covered by a fully enclosed container or compost bin.

Permits must be renewed annually.
